Additional information regarding attempted service, etc.:

Server arrived at [REDACTED] at 3:49PM (MT) on July 30, 2014 to serve William Browder a subpoena. Server knocked on front door several times and pressed the "call" button to the right hand side of the door at least 3 times. Though three small children were seen playing in the front driveway and an adult woman appeared in the window of the side door (to the far right of the front door), no one answered the front door. After several more minutes of knocking, Server left the documents in a standing position against the front door and vacated the address. Additionally, Server observed a Black GMC Yukon with Colorado plates 124-YJS in the front driveway.
